 Character Descriptions

Mildred	Late 50's. Moderately wealthy owner of Country Manor.
Dorothy	Late 20's. Dresses plainly. Companion and housekeeper to her Aunt Mildred.
Bunting	60's. Traditional butler. Likes to nip at the sherry.
Colonel Charles Craddock	Early 60's. Dresses in tweeds. Confident, but blustering manner.
Margaret Craddock	Charles' wife. Somewhat younger than her husband. Bored and easily annoyed.
Pierre Marceau	Early 30's. Speaks with exaggerated French accent. Presents himself as an artist.
Elizabeth Hartley-Trumpington	Mid 20's. Attractive, stunningly dressed. Speaks with exaggerated high society accent. Wears white gloves.
Ms. Joan Maple	"Busy body". In her 60's. Often finds herself in murderous situations.
Inspector Pratt	Inept, posing, clumsy, walking disaster.
Constable Thompkins	Young. Village policeman.

NOTE - Ages are flexible depending on the makeup of the ensemble.
