“Fairy Tales and Fables” Cast & Crew Ready for a Fun Run!

Kirk has always been proud of our children’s shows. Adults and children work together on stage and off to bring magic to our young patrons and their families. This year we are bringing to life a collection of fairy tales and fables from legendary storytellers like Hans Christian Andersen and the Brothers Grimm.

Our creative team has woven these stories into a narrative about a young girl named Sara who has a homework assignment to read seven stories and determine if each one is a fairy tale or a fable. She learns that her sixth-grade class is being paired with second graders resulting in her and her younger brother Gabe exploring this challenge together. The siblings engage in debate as we watch as the talented ensemble bring the stories and characters to life, some stories you may know such as “The Ugly Duckling” and others you may not, such the Russian story “When the Czar’s Son Becomes Sick”.

Director Patrick Blake is pulling this delightful show together. “I am thrilled to be directing this show. We have a remarkable ensemble of children and adults, ages range from 8 to 66 (not our record!). We have just started rehearsals and many of these kids absolutely amaze me.”

Patrick is also grateful for his strong support team. “We have put together a wonderful tech team. I am happy to be working again with Amy Sharer”. Jon Matousek (who has directed our children’s show for many years) will serve as Producer, Bev Karns as Stage Manager, Hannah Chapa as Assistant Stage Manager, Kimberly Barr as Choreographer, Lisa Willems as Technical Director, Brenda Sparks will design the set, Natalie LaVoie will lead the Sound crew and Martin Hill will design Lights for the production.

Patrick is excited about the versatility of the actors and the flexibility of the material. “It is a great mix of new and returning actors. Most everyone is playing multiple roles throughout the various stories. We have intrigue, drama, music and even dancing! It’s gonna be a blast – don’t miss this one!”
